Complete a turn around the traditional Monopoly game board by working stations representing each property as follows. Numbers may be substituted for letters (O for O, 1 for I, 2 for T 3 for E, 4 for A, 5 for F, 6 for B, 7 for L, 8 for AT, 9 for N)

GO	Any callsign with the word GO included in it.	
Mediterranean Ave.	Any callsign with the letters "MED"	
Community Chest	Work any 3 stations in the 1 st call area.	
Baltic Ave.	Any callsign with the letters "BAL"	
Income Tax	Any callsign with the word TAX.	
Reading RR	Any callsign with 3 R's	
Oriental Ave.	Any station located in San Francisco, CA	
Chance?	Work 3 Net Control stations	
Vermont Ave.	Work a station in VT.	
Connecticut Ave.	Work a station in CT.	
Jail	Any callsign containing the letters in "JAIL" or other "penalty" in any order.	
St. Charles Ave.	Any operator named Charles, Chaz, or Charlie.	
Electric Company	A station operating on emergency power (may not be used elsewhere!)	
States Ave.	Work ALL of the 13 original states.	
Virginia Ave.	Work a station in VA.	
Pennsylvania RR.	Work a station in PA with "RR" in the call.	
St. James Ave	Any station operated by a person named James or Jim	
Community Chest	Work 3 stations in the 7 th call area.	
Tennessee Ave.	Work a station in TN.	
New York Ave.	Work a station in NY.	
Free Parking	Any station of your choosing.	
Kentucky Ave.	Work a station in KY.	
Chance?	Work 3 club station calls	
Illinois Ave.	Work a station in IL.	
Indiana Ave.	Work a station in IN.	
B&O Railroad	Work 1 station in Baltimore, MD, and 1 station in OHIO	
Atlantic Ave.	Work a station in any state bordering	

	the Atlantic Ocean or on an Atlantic Island.	
Ventnor Ave.	Any 2x1/1x2 call with a single "V"	
Water Works	Any station operating maritime mobile or from a fixed/moored vessel.	
Marvin Gardens Ave.	Work 3 mobile stations	
Go to Jail	Any station operated by a police officer.	
Pacific Ave.	Work a station in any state bordering the Pacific Ocean or on a Pacific Island.	
Community Chest	Work 3 stations in the 6 th call area	
North Carolina Ave.	Work a station in NC.	
Pennsylvania Ave.	Work a station in PA.	
Short Line Railroad	Work a 1x2 or 2x1 call with the letters RR included or includes "SL"	
Chance?	Work 3 YL stations.	
Park Place	Work a station operating in any national or state park.	
Luxury Tax 75%	Work 1 station in the 7 th call area and 1 in the 5 th call area.	
Boardwalk	Work 1 station located in New York City (any borough)	

Monopoly Award Rules

1. At least 75% of your included callsigns must have been logged on a NATA net. Cards are required for non-NATA contacts.
2. Submit your application via the net's website (www.northamericantrafficandawards.net). Online application forms are available which you can fill out and submit while online. Cards should be scanned and uploaded to the awards director files area. In addition to this application form please attach a text file with complete log information for each contact IN THE ORDER THEY APPEAR ABOVE. eQSL cards may be substituted for log entries (indicate "EQSL" next to callsign in space above).
3. There are no band/net restrictions for this award.
4. To be eligible to apply for this award you must have earned your either your Worked All North America (NATA Award program) or a Worked All States award (either ARRL or our award). Include your WAS certificate number and date issued in the appropriate space on the online application form!
5. You may work on this award while working on other awards.

Award Rules applicable to ALL awards

1. NO QSL CARDS REQUIRED. Our policy is to trust your personal integrity. All nets are logged and the awards director can quickly check dates/times of contacts if necessary. We encourage you to exchange QSL cards but do not require you to submit them for our awards unless the contact was made outside of a NATA net. You may use up to 25% of any award contacts from non-NATA sources. Where an award calls for multiple contacts in a category those must come from our nets. (e.g. Work 3 YL's, etc.).
2. You must hold a Worked All States award (ARRL , NATA, or any other awards recognized by NATA) in order to apply for a NATA award OTHER than the N-WAS.
3. eQSL's are all valid for NATA awards. LOTW entries are valid for NATA awards. We encourage you to upload your logs to both of these electronic QSL services! They're free!!!
4. Awards are normally processed and delivered electronically via our website. If you want us to print and mail your award a fee of \$3.00 per award is charged which may be paid through PayPal or mailed. If you would like to support the awards program with an additional donation please feel free to do so!
